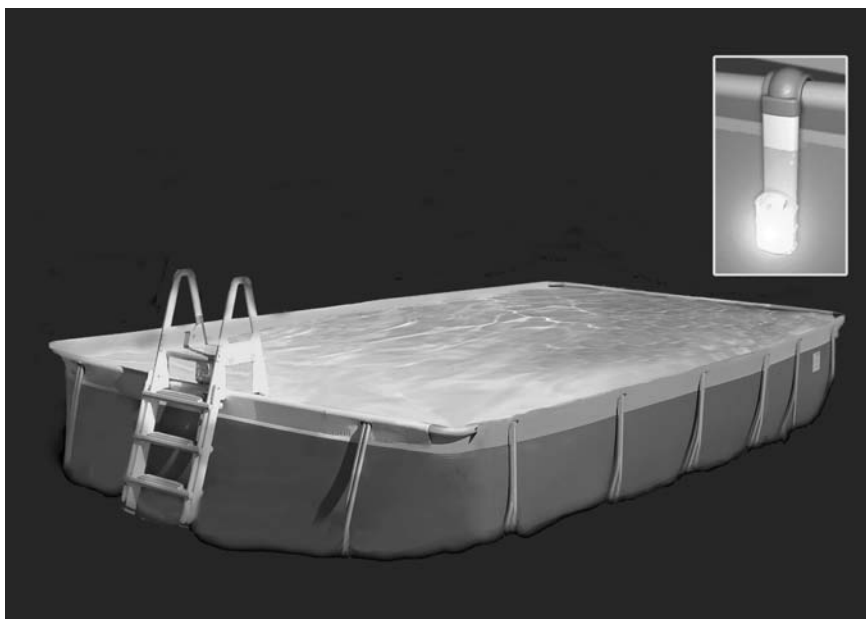

SAFETY

This product meets or exceeds applicable standards established by Underwriters Laboratories Standard 676, Intertek Testing Services, and required standards for use worldwide. It uses only low 12V energy (equivalent to a 12V battery) with multiple layers of redundant safety checks, is constructed of approved materials and is assembled in agency inspected facilities. Please use the following guidelines for your further protection:



WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock, injury, or damage to your product or to bathers:



The sole purpose of this product is for use as an underwater light in an aboveground pool; any modification or other use will void the warranty.



Do not use if unit is damaged in any way.



Use this product only for its intended use as described in this manual.



Unit must be submerged in water to operate properly.



Plug only into 110 V receptacles protected by a ground fault circuit interrupter.



DO NOT USE EXTENSION CORDS, DEATH OR INJURY CAN RESULT.



Make sure NiteLighter is unplugged from its power supply before replacing the bulb or lens or performing any other maintenance.



To protect risk of electrical shock, do not put the transformer in water or other liquid.



To avoid damage to the transformer and cord, never carry the transformer by the cord or yank to disconnect from an outlet. Instead, disconnect by pulling the plug itself from the outlet. Do not pull cord around sharp corners or edges.



Do not operate with a damaged cord or transformer.



Disconnect transformer from outlet when not in use.

Installation:

1. Hang the light fixture onto the rail of your pool, as shown. Keep the light fixture vertical. Make sure the top of the clear lens is at least 3 inches below the water level.



2. Hold the smaller metal piece against the underside of the rail and push up; then tighten up the 2 screws that hold the 2 pieces together.



3. Adjust the 2 hex socket head set screws until the metal clamp grips the rail tightly.

Slide the smaller plastic up and attach it to the lower part of the metal clamp by the 4 smaller screws. Tuck the wire in the trough of the metal clamp.

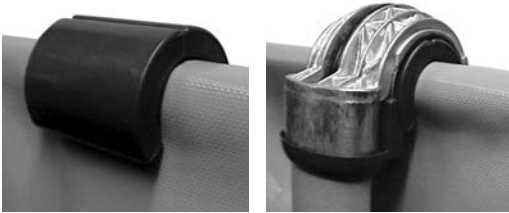
4. Cover the metal clamp with the plastic cap. Push it down until it fits snugly with the light fixture.



You may bury the wire in a shallow slot in the ground to hide it but would allow for easy removal.

The transformer should be mounted to a convenient surface. Mount the transformer off the ground approximately 18 inches using the keyhole slot in the casing.

Plug only into a 110V outlet protected by a ground fault circuit interrupter.



NOTE:

For smaller diameter rails, place the small rail adapter (provided) onto the rail prior to hanging the metal clamp (see accompanying picture).

Operation:

Operate only when the light is submerged in water.

After plugging in, push the rubber button to activate. Rotate the knob on the transformer to use high or low setting. The light automatically turns off in approximately 3 hours for convenience and longevity.



WINTERIZATION

IMPORTANT:

You must remove your light when closing your pool for the winter. Simply reverse the installation procedure to remove. The original display box can be used for storage. Your warranty does not cover freezing of the product.



SIX MONTH LIMITED WARRANTY

Six month limited warranty from date of original purchase for manufacturing defects under normal and reasonable use, and subject to the maintenance requirements and installation guidelines set forth in the product instruction manual.
